ALAFS awards a \$500 scholarship to one deserving **graduate student** each year at the annual meeting. The scholarship can be used in any way to support the student's graduate education. ALAFS asks that applicants present their research at the annual meeting.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Currently enrolled in a graduate degree program at an Alabama accredited educational institution with a research focus in fisheries, aquaculture, or the aquatic sciences.
2. Currently in good academic standing.
3. Must have a research proposal that is approved by their graduate advisory committee.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

1. A copy of transcripts for undergraduate and graduate work completed to date
2. A letter of recommendation from the student's major professor (must indicate the student is currently enrolled in good standing and their research proposal was approved by the advisory committee)
3. A letter of recommendation from another professional reference
4. A copy of the complete research proposal
5. A short essay (1,000 words) describing why you are pursuing a career in the aquatic sciences.
